

SCOPE OF WORK FOR AN EXPANDED HISTORIC STRUCTURE  
INVENTORY OF THE UNITED STATES  
MILITARY ACADEMY AT WEST POINT, NEW YORK

I. INTRODUCTION

This Scope of Work describes an expanded historic structure inventory for the partial fulfillment of the obligations of the U.S. Department of the Army, West Point regarding cultural resources, set forth in the Historic Preservation Act of 1966 (P.L. 89-665) and the Amendments of 1980, the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (P.L. 91-190), Executive Order 11593 for the Protection and Enhancement of the Cultural Environment (13 May 1971, 36 C.F.R. 8921), the Archaeological Conservation Act of 1974 (P.L. 93-291), the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation's "Procedures for the Protection of Historic and Cultural Properties" (36 C.F.R., Part 800), the Department of the Interior's guidelines concerning cultural resources (36 C.F.R., Part 60, and Interim Regulations Parts 32, 60, 61, 63, 64, 65, 66) and the Corps of Engineers Regulations (ER1105-2-460) "Identification and Administration of Cultural Resources" (Federal Register 3 April 1978).

II. BACKGROUND

The United States Military Academy (USMA) at West Point was designated a National Historic Landmark (NHL) in 1961 and the boundaries of the historic district were established, encompassing an area of approximately 2,500 acres. Located within these boundaries are structures dating from 1820. Many of the structures possess strong historical associations and distinctive architectural qualities representative of a variety of national styles; others are modern or utilitarian type structures. The Academy owns an additional 13,474 acres outside the NHL District. The total number of structures within the NHL District and the outlying area is 1308. Fifteen miles to the north the Academy owns 419 structures located on 416 acres at Stewart Air Station (STAS). These structures date from World War II through the 1960s.

A general historical and architectural study of the Academy was undertaken in 1970 for the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation in connection with the Academy's development plan. This study, undertaken by the Office of Archeology and Historic Preservation of the National Park Service, was published in November of that year. While this report provided good background data and discussed some of the most important buildings, no structure by structure inventory was accomplished at that time.

III. OBJECTIVES

The purpose of the tasks itemized below is to identify and evaluate the historic structures of the USMA in order to accomplish the following objectives:

- A. The data collected will form the data base needed for a systematic historic preservation program at the Academy and the preparation of a historic structure maintenance plan.
- B. The USMA will meet its Federal responsibilities to identify the historic cultural properties under its control and partially fulfill its further responsibilities in regard to protection and enhancement of identified historic cultural properties as those responsibilities are mandated in the above mentioned legislation.
- C. Copies of the documentation resulting from the project will be transmitted to the Library of Congress to become part of the Historic American Buildings Survey archives.

IV. TASKS

- A. Inventory of all structures on Academy owned property.

A structure by structure inventory of 1308 structures and all monuments on the 15,974 acres owned by the Academy will be completed. A Historic American Buildings Survey/Historic American Engineering Record (HABS/HAER) Inventory Card will be filled out on each structure or on each group of identical structures. In the majority of the cases exteriors only will be inventoried. 35mm photography will be used to document each building or group of identical buildings.

The Inventory will be conducted according to HABS/HAER inventory standards.

A document search and drive-through survey of the 419 structures owned by the Academy at STAS. A summary of the results will be included in the final report. Individual HABS/HAER Inventory Cards will be filled out only on structures that are found to be potentially significant.

An archeological investigation of Academy-owned property also represents an important priority. This present study, however, deals only with historic structures and will not be designed to identify historic sites for which there is no existent structures or for which there are only foundations extant. However, the document search will be extended to include past structures, type and location, which were situated within the boundaries of the post proper.

- B. Categorization of all structures based on identified historical and architectural values. Preparation of site maps showing inventoried buildings color coded as to category.

The categories defined in the U.S. Army's Historic Preservation Procedures TM-5-801-1, 1975 will be used as the basis for the categorization process. The categories will be modified to reflect the historical and architectural values particular to USMA, West Point such as military Gothic architecture, student

activities and academic life, relationships to the regional architecture, the role of the railroad, etc. A fifth category for intrusions will be added.

C. Development of General Preservation Guidelines for each category.

These guidelines will address the type of historic maintenance, preservation or restoration appropriate for each category providing a framework in which more specific recommendations can be developed.

D. Photodocumentation and written histories and descriptions of all Category I and selected Category II structures. This entails full Historic American Buildings Survey (HABS) documentation excepting measured drawings.

Written documentation will follow HABS format and standards as reiterated in the Historian's Procedures Manual (HABS, Department of the Interior, Washington, D.C.). Photography will be 4" x 5" format and follow Photographic Specifications for Contract Photographers, HABS and Historic American Engineering Record (HAER), Department of the Interior, Washington, D.C.

E. Identification of important historic and architectural features, both exterior and interior, on a building by building basis or for a group of similar buildings for all Category I and selected Category II building, including dates of modifications and analysis of importance of particular features to the building's historical and architectural values. Based on this analysis a recommended "ideal appearance" will be developed for each building or group of buildings. This will involve determining whether the original appearance or the condition of the building at some later time represents the desired appearance of the building.

V. FINAL REPORT

A. Additional Requirements

1. A methodology describing in detail how the inventory was accomplished, the buildings were categorized, preservation guidelines were determined, historic and architectural features were identified and evaluated, and recommended ideal appearances of Category I and selected Category II buildings were determined.
2. Historical and architectural overviews of the Academy which described the context in which evaluations were made.
3. A tabular listing of buildings giving categories and suggested preservation guidelines. Other tabular summaries as appropriate.

4. Contact sheet size prints will be drymounted to the back of the appropriate inventory card. Large format prints will be placed on photo mount cards. Both will be properly captioned.

B. Format

Each section of the report will be organized in such a way that it can be readily utilized by USMA personnel.

C. Number of Copies and Disposition of Data

1. The original of the draft and final reports and fifteen photocopies of each will be submitted to the USMA.
2. One photocopy on archival paper will be submitted to HABS for transmittal to the architectural archives at the Library of Congress. All negatives and one contact print of each film roll in the case of 35mm photography and all negatives and one 4" x 5" print in the case of large format photography will be submitted to HABS for transmittal to the Library of Congress. Photo identification sheets should accompany inventory photographs.



- A. Contractor will be responsible for transportation and housing for personnel during the field work phase.
- B. USMA will provide assistance in gaining access to records at the Academy and to interiors of buildings and in obtaining any other special permission required to execute properly the above tasks. This will include obtaining a parking permit for vehicle(s) belonging to field team members.
- C. USMA will furnish office space, office equipment and use of a telephone for field personnel.
- D. Personnel of the Directorate of Engineering and Housing will be available by appointment for interviews with field personnel regarding structures at the Academy.

Dear Ms. Tompkins:

With reference to your conversations with Mr. Michael Moss regarding your work at West Point, inclosed is a list of our accessioned cannon and a few other related items that decorate the perimeter area of the Plain.

The list has been split to show two major areas. Trophy Point faces north, up river and the remaining parapet of Fort Clinton, facing east to the river.

References exist to mass displays of cannon in the area since the end of the Revolutionary War. Trophy Point as we know it was formalized sometime in the 1850's. Long rows of guns appear in photographs of Fort Clinton in the 1880's when the Fort was still used for cadet training. What remains at these locations has been for the most part unchanged since the scrap drive in 1942.

The list submitted, used our current accession numbering system. Most of the cannon bear brass tags showing an older numbering system. These older tags have not been removed nor new numbers added to stop further defacement. We, of course, have a cross reference for the numbers. If we can provide any other information, please let us know.

## INTRODUCTION

- Task:** To review all original drawings of those structures designated Category I and Category II per the Historic American Buildings Survey (HABS), National Park Service (NPS) Inventory.
- Objective:** To select those architectural drawings of significance as original historic documents or artistic works for inclusion in the United States Military Academy archives.
- Goal:** To preserve and conserve these architectural drawings and to provide a permanent and accurate record through the United States Military Academy (U.S.M.A.) archives of these Category I and Category II structures.

## BACKGROUND

Since 1933 HABS has been documenting architectural and engineering sites of national significance with architectural measured drawings, large format photographs and historical data. This documentation comprises the largest architectural archives of its kind and is maintained through the Library of Congress where it is made available to scholars, professionals, researchers, and the general public.

HABS is currently documenting a number of buildings at the United States Military Academy in conjunction with an expanded historic structures inventory being conducted there. That documentation consists of historical and architectural data and large format photographs. Because no measured drawings, which form the major type of HABS documentation, are being executed, the preservation and accessibility of the existent drawings through the U.S.M.A. is crucial as that part of the documentation that will not be included in the Library of Congress.

The following report will detail not only those architectural drawings selected for transmittal to the U.S.M.A. archives, but also the reason and methodology used for their selection.

## CURRENT CONDITIONS

There are approximately 9,500 architectural drawings documenting 142 Category I and Category II structures. The drawings are maintained through the Engineering, Plans and Services Division and serviced for staff and reference use on a regular basis. Although the drawings are stored in a secure area with limited access, there are no temperature or humidity controls. The drawings are retrieved, reproduced, and refiled competently by trained staff members only. However, original drawings, instead of reproducible copies, are used for reproduction and reference purposes resulting in damage and deterioration in some cases from the use of Scotch tape, acidic ink, rubber bands, paper clips, or exposure to sun light.

## METHODOLOGY

Due to time limitations a cut off date of 1940 was set for the review of drawings. Many post-1940 drawings are as valuable as historical documents and should be reviewed for transmittal at a later date.

All original drawings dated before 1940 were reviewed systematically by structure and then by date; oldest drawings being studied first. At that time determination for transmittal to the U.S.M.A. archives was made based on the following criteria:

- 1) significance as an original historic document
- 2) artistic merit
- 3) condition

Priority was given to those drawings recording buildings being documented by HABS. A permanent record that is readily accessible to the public is a necessary standard upon which HABS historical documentation is based. Not only were the original working drawings of a building selected, but also those drawings illustrating major alterations or additions.

The following conditions were also factors that determined transmittals:

- Complete sets of drawings

A single elevation or detail of a building may be more valuable as an artistic record but loses significance as an historical document when removed from its original context of a complete set. Similarly, structural, mechanical, or electrical plans by themselves are not as important as when they support other drawings within the context of a set of working drawings. Therefore, whenever possible, complete sets of drawings were selected for transmittal.

- Current condition of the drawing

Some drawings are in such poor condition that the original is in jeopardy of being lost altogether without immediate conservation and proper storage. For drawings in deteriorated condition it is suggested that not only the original be transmitted to the U.S.M.A. archives but also a full scale copy either on vellum or mylar, both of which meet archival standards and are also reproducible. This has been noted on the attached list.

- Lack of original drawings

If no original drawings exist, either later drawings or existing copies made from the originals were selected for transmittal. For example, there are no original construction drawings for the Old Cadet Chapel. However, there is a comprehensive set of

drawings dating from 1909-1910, when the building was moved to its present site, that represents an accurate record of the structure and therefore was selected for inclusion in the archives. If reproductions of the original drawings are the only remaining record of the structure, photocopies or another suitable copy should be transmitted to the archives as a permanent record, as in the case of the Railroad Station.

A list was prepared as drawings were selected for transmittal to the U.S.M.A. archives. The drawings were arranged by building number and name, the date as noted on the drawings, the sheet number of the drawing, and the file number, if applicable, assigned by U.S.M.A. The drawings are grouped within buildings by their current storage arrangement in rolls. For each drawing it is then noted if the original drawing, a reproduction of the original, or both should be transmitted. Both the original and a reproduction are suggested for transmittal for damaged or deteriorated drawings. A copy at this time is crucial before further deterioration destroys the original. Suggested types of reproductions are also noted: mylar, an archival plastic that is extremely durable and reproducible; vellum, which is also archival and reproducible; or photocopies made from a photographic negative.

#### CONSERVATION

It is also recommended that steps be taken immediately to conserve drawings while they are maintained and used in the engineering office:

- Original drawings

Original drawings should not be used for reproduction purposes. Electrostatic copies on vellum should be made for many of the drawings. The vellum copy is inexpensive, archivally stable, and is reproducible. A reproducible copy on mylar, although more expensive than vellum, is more durable and should be made for drawings that are frequently handled or reproduced. Running original drawings through a reproduction machine such as the Bruning PD 160 model should be avoided as they can be torn and ink smeared. Suggested types of reproductions for use in the engineering office are also noted on the list.

- Ball point ink

Ball point ink should never be used on the original drawings for notations. This ink contains acid that can migrate through paper.

- Pencil drawings

Pencil drawings should be interleaved with acid free tissue and stored flat to prevent abrasion and smudging.

- Rubber bands

Rubber bands should never be used on original drawings. Rubber bands deteriorate rapidly and adhere to the surface causing discoloration and possible tearing.

- Paper clips

Paper clips should not be used. They will rust and discolor or deteriorate the surface.

- Transparent pressure sensitive tape

Transparent pressure sensitive tape, such as "scotch tape" is extremely damaging and should never be used on original drawings. The adhesive on such tape becomes very sticky with time, will discolor and deteriorate paper, and contains acid that will migrate to adjacent surfaces. If a tape must be used, a more archivally stable brand should be used.

#### CONCLUSION

In conclusion, it is recommended that all drawings listed be transmitted to the U.S.M.A. archives. Priority should be given to those drawings that will supplement documentation being produced by HABS for inclusion in the Library of Congress.

The original drawings requiring copies at this time should have this done to insure their preservation as permanent records. Restoration and repair of these drawings is also recommended because of their value not only as historic documents but also as artistic works.
